## **BILLING INFORMATION**

Currently, in our lesson program, 10 month students pay \$12.00 per month more than our 12 month students. This ensures the student's placement in our fall schedules. Our 10 month plan includes thirty seven lessons, late August through the end of May, which is billed in ten equal monthly payments. Our 12 month plan includes forty-four lessons billed equally over the calendar year. This includes a 7 week summer session in June and July.

**ALL students must take the equivalent of 7 lessons during the summer session to maintain your 12 month tuition rate. Fewer than 7 lessons will cause your monthly rate to increase by \$12.00 per student/per month. This increase will occur during the month of August.**

We encourage you to think about taking lessons over the summer. Consistent playing throughout the year benefits your child in their musical learning.
